Annual Parish Outing – Saturday 15 June 2019 – We visit the National Stud and Japanese Gardens in Co Kildare, home to Ireland's most famous racehorses. The Irish National Stud is a thoroughbred horse facility in Tully, Co Kildare, established in 1946 and owned now by the State. It is a unique attraction bringing visitors from all over the world. The Japanese Gardens were created between 1906 – 1910 by Japanese craftsman Tessa Eida and his son and the beautifully designed St Fiachra's Gardens created to celebrate the Millennium commemorate the Patron Saint of gardeners, St Fiachra. We travel by coach to the National Stud where we will have coffee and scones followed by a guided tour of the Stud Farm and the Museum. You will then be free to explore and enjoy the beautiful gardens and woodland walks. Time permitting we hope to include a short visit to The Kildare Outlet Village just a short distance away.
